- **Baines Report Fellowship Applicants:** Include a letter of interest, a current resume, two writing samples and one well-planned story idea.
- **Retired State Employees Association Applicants:** Include a one-page essay that has examples of your commitment to Texas State government and verification of your interest in pursuing careers in state government in Texas upon graduation.
- **Deans Graduate Fellowship Applicants:** Include the following essay questions: Briefly describe why you should be considered for a Deans Fellowship (250 word maximum) and a brief narrative account that describes your financial need situation (250 word maximum).
